"Maintenance, as used in this section, shall include the right of the holder of the prescriptive easement to temporarily remove infrastructure in or spanning the water conveyance system provided that:

- (A) Before the temporary removal for maintenance purposes of infrastructure that a landowner uses for ingress or egress, the holder of the prescriptive easement shall provide reasonable written notice given the extent and estimated time for maintenance but in no case shall notice be provided less than forty-eight (48) hours before any temporary removal;
- (B) Any temporary removal of a landowner's infrastructure for the purpose of water conveyance system maintenance shall be reasonable and minimize any burden on the landowner.".

Page 3-after line 10 insert:

- "(e) The width of a prescriptive easement for a water conveyance shall be based on the size and volume of water in the conveyance system and shall:
- (i) Be of a reasonable width sufficient to utilize equipment suitable for the operation and maintenance of the water conveyance;
- (ii) Be from the center line of the conveyance system but may vary from each side of the center line to reasonably facilitate the size of equipment, placement of dredge material and the topography that the conveyance system traverses.".
