(a) Of this other funds appropriation, fifty million dollars (\$50,000,000.00)S13 four million dollars (\$4,000,000.00)S13 is appropriated for the construction or renovation of the Corbett natatorium, construction or renovation of the west stands at war memorial stadium, renovation or additions to the college of law, or any combination thereof. Any amount allocated for renovations or additions to the college of law is effective immediately. Expenditure of this appropriation is conditioned upon a match of funds in the ratio of one dollar (\$1.00) of appropriated funds from the strategic investments and projects account to not less than one dollar (\$1.00) from any other source from the University of Wyoming. The following shall apply to this other funds appropriation from the strategic investments and projects account:
- (i) This appropriation shall be directed to the state treasurer to be deposited into an account for distribution to the university;

(ii) Binding commitments for donations are eligible for the matching funds under this appropriation if the donation will be fully paid by December 31, 2027. Not less than quarterly, the state treasurer shall distribute to the university matching funds under this footnote for any donation or other funds eligible for the match upon receipt of proof of a binding commitment for the donation or availability of other funds."

- (d) All sums paid to the commission under this act except contributions from permittees to the breeder award fund, amounts paid under paragraphs (b)(iii) and (iv) of this section, fines and penalties shall be credited to the pari-mutuel account which shall be used by the commission for the payment of all expenses incurred in enforcing this act. On a quarterly basis, the commission shall transfer amounts within the account in excess of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00) to the state treasurer for credit to the legislative stabilization reserve account, except as provided in subsection (n) of this section. All fines and penalties collected under this act shall be paid to the state treasurer and credited as provided in W.S. 8-1-109. The state treasurer shall pay out of the account all warrants drawn by the state auditor, upon vouchers issued and signed by the president, vice-president or executive secretary of the commission. The commission shall keep an accurate and true account of all funds received and all vouchers issued by the commission. All funds received and all vouchers issued by the commission shall be audited at least biennially by the director of the state department of audit or his designee and a copy of the audit shall be delivered within thirty (30) days after completion to the governor and the commission. The costs of the audit shall be borne by the commission. The members of the commission shall receive per diem and mileage as provided in W.S. 33-1-302(a)(vii), and compensation of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each day during which they are actually engaged in the discharge of their duties. The total expenses incurred by the commission shall not exceed the total amount in the pari-mutuel account.
- (n) For fiscal year 2024, of the amounts in the pari-mutuel account in excess of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00), the state treasurer shall, on July 1, 2023, transfer one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00), or as much as is available, to the commission for purposes of grants to publicly owned horse racing facilities in Wyoming in accordance with this subsection. Any unexpended, unobligated funds transferred under this section shall revert to the pari-mutuel account on July 1, 2024. Grants awarded under this subsection shall be in accordance with the following:

Section 4. There is created the University of Wyoming student housing account. Funds from the account shall be expended for the University of Wyoming student housing project as provided in this act. The treasurer shall disburse funds from the account upon request of the University of Wyoming board of trustees. Funds in the account appropriated under Section 7(b) of this act may only be expended by the trustees of the university for the payment of principal and interest on any outstanding securities issued by the university as of March 1, 2019 and funds appropriated under Section 7(a) of this act may only be expended by the trustees of the university for other initial costs of construction for phase 1 and phase 2 of the student housing project. Funds in the account shall be invested by the state treasurer's office. Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008 and 9-4-207, any earnings from the account shall be credited to the legislative stabilization reserve account. The University of Wyoming shall repay on a twenty (20) year accrual schedule all funds expended by the university from the account at an annually adjusted interest rate of one-quarter of one percent (.25%) higher than the return received by the state in the immediately preceding fiscal year on the portion of the legislative stabilization reserve account that is not invested in equities. The interest rate shall be capped at a maximum rate of four and one-half percent (4.5%) per annum. All interest and principal payments made by the university in repayment of monies expended from the account shall be credited to the legislative stabilization reserve account. The University of Wyoming board of trustees may dedicate any available funds to repay funds expended from this account. Repayment of funds under this section shall commence on July 1 of the year following the year in which the funds were expended. Notwithstanding any other provision of law and subject to section 7(a) and (b) of this act, all unobligated and unencumbered funds in the account on June 30, 2029 shall revert to the legislative stabilization reserve account.

Section 7.

(a) There is continuously appropriated not more than fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000.00) at any one (1) time, except as otherwise provided in this section from the legislative stabilization reserve account to the University of Wyoming student housing account created by this act. Funds from this appropriation may only be expended by the trustees of the university for initial costs of construction for phase 1 and phase 2 of the student housing project. All unexpended, unobligated funds appropriated under this subsection shall revert

to the legislative stabilization reserve account on March 24, 2023.

(b) There is appropriated thirty-four million dollars (\$34,000,000.00) from the legislative stabilization reserve account to the University of Wyoming student housing account created by this act. Funds from this appropriation may only be expended by the trustees of the University of Wyoming for the payment of principal and interest on any outstanding securities issued by the university as of March 1, 2019. All unexpended, unobligated funds appropriated under this subsection shall revert to the legislative stabilization reserve account on March 24, 2023.".

- (i) The grant shall only be awarded to a city with a population greater than ten thousand (10,000), calculated based on the last federal census;
- (ii) Expenditure of any grant by a recipient is conditioned upon a cash match of funds in the ratio of one dollar (\$1.00) of grant funds to not less than one dollar (\$1.00) from any other source;
- (iii) This appropriation shall revert to the general fund if no grant is awarded under this subsection or if granted funds are not encumbered or obligated by June 30, 2024.".
