Medicaid twelve month postpartum coverage.

## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to medical assistance and services;
- 2 temporarily extending Medicaid medical assistance to
- 3 qualifying pregnant women for twelve (12) months
- 4 postpartum; making a conforming amendment; providing an
- 5 appropriation; requiring rulemaking; and providing for
- 6 effective dates.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1**. W.S. 42-4-122(b) by creating a new
- 11 paragraph (iii) is amended to read:

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13 **42-4-122.** Cooperation with paternity determination.

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- 1 (b) The following persons are not required to
- 2 cooperate with the department pursuant to subsection (a) of
- 3 this section:

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- 5 (iii) A person who has been pregnant within the
- 6 preceding twelve (12) months. This paragraph is repealed
- 7 effective March 31, 2027.

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- 9 **Section 2.** Pursuant to the authority granted by
- 10 Sections 9812 and 9822 of the American Rescue Plan Act of
- 11 2021 (P.L. 117-2), the department of health shall apply for
- 12 state plan amendments to provide extended postpartum
- 13 coverage to pregnant individuals enrolled in Medicaid
- 14 pursuant to the Wyoming Medical Assistance and Services Act
- 15 or enrolled in the Child Health Insurance Plan.
- 16 Authorization for extended postpartum coverage under this
- 17 section shall end on March 31, 2027.

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- 19 **Section 3.** There is appropriated three million eight
- 20 hundred thousand dollars (\$3,800,000.00) from the general
- 21 fund and three million eight hundred thousand dollars
- 22 (\$3,800,000.00) from federal funds to the department of
- 23 health for purposes of providing temporary medical

- 1 assistance to pregnant women in accordance with this act
- 2 for the period beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30,
- 3 2024. This appropriation shall not be transferred or
- 4 expended for any other purpose and any unexpended,
- 5 unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation on June
- 6 30, 2024 shall revert as provided by law. The department of
- 7 health shall include funding for this program in their next
- 8 biennial budget request.

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- 10 **Section 4.** The department of health shall promulgate
- 11 any rules necessary to implement this act.

13 Section 5.

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- 15 (a) Except as otherwise provided by subsection (b) of
- 16 this section, this act is effective July 1, 2023.

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- 18 (b) Sections 4 and 5 of this act are effective
- 19 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a
- 20 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of
- 21 the Wyoming Constitution.
