1 AN ACT relating to elections; amending the definition of 2 registry list to include voter identification numbers and absentee ballot requests and returns; making conforming 3 4 amendments; and providing for an effective date. 5 б Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 Section 1. W.S. 22-1-102(a)(xxix), 22-2-113(d) and 8 22-3-108(a)(vi) and by creating new paragraphs (viii) and 9 10 (ix) are amended to read: 11 12 22-1-102. Definitions. 13 14 (a) The definitions contained in this chapter apply 15 to words and phrases used in this Election Code and govern

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the construction of those words and phrases unless they are 1 2 specifically modified by the context in which they appear. 3 As used in this Election Code: 4 5 (xxix) "Registry list" is the list by precinct 6 of the names, addresses, party affiliations, unique identifying numbers generated by the state, information 7 8 relating to absentee ballot requests and returns and 9 precinct and district numbers of the registered electors in 10 the county prepared by the secretary of state or county clerks for distribution as provided in W.S. 22-2-113; 11 12 22-2-113. Availability and form of registry lists; 13 14 use of copies; election record; purging. 15 16 (d) Unless otherwise specifically stated in this Election Code, all election records of the county clerk are 17 public. The availability and dissemination of such records 18 19 shall be in accordance with the Wyoming Public Records Act. 20 Election records containing social security numbers, 21 portions of social security numbers, driver's license numbers, birth dates, telephone numbers, tribal 22 identification card numbers, e-mail addresses and other 23

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1 personally identifiable information other than names, 2 gender, addresses, unique identifying numbers generated by 3 the state and party affiliations are not public records and 4 shall be kept confidential. When necessary, members of the county or state canvassing boards may access confidential 5 information for purposes of this code but shall maintain 6 7 its confidentiality. 8 9 22-3-108. Official registry list information. 10 (a) The official registry list shall contain at least 11 12 the following information as to each registered elector: 13 14 (vi) Date of birth; and 15 16 (viii) A unique identifying number generated by 17 the state; and 18 19 (ix) Information relating to absentee ballot 20 requests and returns. 21
