Proof of the 8 existence of the sign, marker, warning, notice or direction placed or given under W.S. 24-1-108 located before and in 9 10 the same direction of travel as the location where the 11 person was cited for violation of this section shall 12 constitute prima facie evidence of a violation of this 13 subsection. 14 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2023. 15 16
