9 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

11 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-9-502(a) by creating a new

12 paragraph (viii), 19-9-503(a)(intro), (ii) through (iv),

13 (b)(intro), (iii) through (v) and by creating a new

14 subsection (c) and 19-9-504(a)(i), (ii)(B), (iii), (iv) and

1 residents may receive benefits as provided in paragraphs 2 (i) and (ii) of this subsection, but the benefit payment 3 shall not exceed the amount of tuition and mandatory fees 4 which that would have been charged if the member or the spouse or dependent under subsection (c) of this section 5 were a Wyoming resident; 6 7 8 (iv) Payment shall be made directly to the institution after the institution officially certifies that 9 10 the member or the spouse or dependent under subsection (c) 11 of this section has registered; 12 13 (v) Payments under the plan together with any federal tuition assistance received by the member or the 14 spouse or dependent under subsection (c) of this section 15 16 shall not exceed one hundred percent (100%) of the tuition 17 and mandatory fees charged. 18 19 (c) Members of the Wyoming national guard who meet

the standards for satisfactory participation in the Wyoming national guard, upon completion of their initial mandatory service obligation under paragraph (a)(iii) of this section, may transfer any Wyoming national guard

1 educational assistance plan benefits that have not reached 2 the limits under W.S. 19-9-504(a) and (c) to their spouse 3 or dependent to be paid in accordance with subsection (b) 4 of this section. The transfer of benefits by the member 5 requires the member to agree in writing to serve in the 6 Wyoming national guard for not less than four (4) 7 additional years after the date the benefit has been 8 transferred. This four (4) year period of service is in addition to the six (6) year commitment period required by 9 10 paragraph (a)(iii) of this section. The member's spouse or 11 dependent may subsequently transfer any remaining benefits 12 that have not reached the limits under W.S. 19-9-504(a) and (c) back to the member to use subject to this section. The 13 member and the member's spouse or dependent cannot use the 14 15 benefits concurrently.

17 19-9-504. Restrictions; repayment of benefits.

19 (a) Plan participation and benefit payments shall be 20 subject to the following additional restrictions and 21 qualifications:

22

1 (i) The plan may be used to complete only one 2 (1) degree, certificate or other educational objective, 3 except as authorized under subsection (c) of this section; 4 5 (ii) Participation shall be limited to the earlier of: 6 7 8 (B) The participant's completion of his the participant's one (1) degree, certificate or other 9 10 educational objective, unless authorized for additional 11 education under subsection (c) of this section. 12 (iii) Any member receiving educational 13 assistance under the plan, or whose spouse or dependent is 14 receiving educational assistance under the plan, who fails 15 16 to maintain satisfactory participation in the active 17 Wyoming national guard shall repay all educational assistance granted under the plan for that current academic 18 19 term. The member, or the member's spouse or dependent if 20 applicable, shall be ineligible for educational assistance 21 under the plan until the adjutant general has determined that 22 the member meets the minimum requirements for 23 satisfactory membership in the Wyoming national guard;

2 (iv) Any member who has received assistance 3 under the plan and who fails to complete the initial six 4 (6) year commitment required by W.S. 19-9-503(a)(iii) and 5 maintain satisfactory participation in the active—Wyoming national guard for the two (2) year period required by W.S. 6 7 19-9-503(a)(iv), or who fails to complete any additional 8 commitment under subsection (c) of this section or under W.S. 19-9-503(c), shall repay all educational assistance 9 10 received under the plan.

12 (c) The plan may be used to complete authorized 13 courses to complete one (1) additional degree, certificate or other educational objective beyond the one (1) degree, 14 certificate or other educational objective authorized in 15 paragraph (a)(i) of this section if the member agrees in 16 17 writing to serve in the Wyoming national guard for not less 18 than four (4) years in addition to the six (6) year 19 commitment period required by W.S. 19-9-503(a)(iii) and the 20 two (2) year commitment period required by W.S. 19-9-503(a)(iv). 21

1 Section 2. There is appropriated seven hundred 2 forty-five thousand five hundred twenty-nine 3 (\$745,529.00) from the general fund to the Wyoming military 4 department for the purposes of paying the educational assistance benefits under this act. 5 This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with the 6 7 effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2024. This 8 appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any 9 purpose and any unexpended, unobligated remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 10 by law on June 30, 2024. It is the intent of 11 the 12 legislature that this appropriation be included in the military department's standard budget for the immediately 13 14 succeeding fiscal biennium.

16 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
