1 (a) For purposes of this article: 2 3 (i) "Customer data" means a customer's banking, 4 transaction and other financial data; 5 (ii) "Express written consent" means a 6 7 customer's affirmative written response to a clear and 8 conspicuous notice regarding the collection, use or 9 disclosure of customer data for the purposes of open 10 banking; 11 12 (iii) "Open banking" means providing access, directly or indirectly, to customer data from the 13 customer's bank to a third-party financial service provider 14 with the express written consent of the customer and 15 16 through the use of application programming interfaces. 17 13-1-702. Open banking authorized; regulation. 18 19 20 (a) A bank may participate in and provide for open 21 banking. 22

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1 (b) A bank participating in and providing for open 2 banking shall comply with all applicable state and federal 3 laws and regulations including laws and regulations related 4 to the protection and use of customer data. Prior to 5 providing access to any customer data under this section 6 the participating bank shall obtain a customer's express 7 written consent.

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9 (c) The commissioner shall adopt rules regulating the 10 collection, use and disclosure of customer data in open 11 banking, consistent with all applicable state and federal 12 laws and regulations.

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Section 2. The banking commissioner shall adopt all rules necessary to implement this act on or before July 1, 2024.
