9	Section 1. W.S. 6-4-304(a)(intro) is amended to read:

13	(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, a
14	person is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
15	imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, a fine of

1	not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), or
2	both, if he, without the consent of the person being
3	viewed, commits the crime of voyeurism by looking or
4	viewing in a clandestine, surreptitious, prying or
5	secretive nature into <u>or within</u> an area where the person
6	being viewed has a reasonable expectation of privacy,
7	including, but not limited to:

9	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
