1 AN ACT relating to senior citizen service districts;
2 specifying how senior citizen service revenues may be
3 expended; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 18-15-111(a)(intro), (i), (ii) and by
8 creating a new paragraph (iv) is amended to read:

9

10 **18-15-111. Fund; disposition of revenue; contract**
11 **requirements.**

13 (a) The revenues collected under the tax levy
14 authorized by W.S. 18-15-110 shall be remitted by the
15 county treasurer to the district to a separate account and

1 shall be used solely for senior citizen programs or
2 services authorized by this subsection and for the payment
3 of bond premiums authorized by W.S. 18-15-108(b).~~7. but~~
4 ~~shall not be used for the purchase of real property or for~~
5 ~~capital construction expenditures.~~ For purposes of this
6 section, senior citizen programs or services are limited to
7 the following:

8
9 (i) ~~Establishment~~ Expansion, renovation,
10 improvement or maintenance of ~~programs or services for~~
11 facilities owned, occupied or to be occupied by senior
12 citizen centers and operational expenses of senior citizen
13 centers, including utilities and other recurring expenses;

14
15 (ii) ~~The expansion of existing~~ Programs provided
16 by or through a senior citizen ~~centers to provide programs~~
17 such as center including but not limited to nutrition,
18 health, in-home services, socialization or transportation;
19 ~~or~~

21 (iv) Assistance to income based or income
22 restricted housing facilities within the district that are
23 designated for senior citizens. Assistance under this

1 subsection may include maintenance costs and upgrades to
2 address code or safety issues with the income based or
3 income restricted housing facilities.

5 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
