1 (xxxix) Define "unexcused absence", "habitual 2 truant" and "willful absenteeism" for all students who are 3 attending public schools and establish rules regarding 4 student attendance. For purposes of this paragraph, an 5 absence preapproved by the district or an absence due to an illness, injury or the health care needs of the student or 6 a death or serious illness in the student's family shall 7 8 not constitute an unexcused absence. Students participating in the annual state fair held under W.S. 11-10-101 as an 9 10 exhibitor or events associated with participation in the 11 annual state fair shall be considered as participating in a district cocurricular activity program and the student's 12 absence shall be defined by the board as an excused 13 14 absence. Nothing in this paragraph shall prohibit a school district from requesting verification of the reasons for an 15 16 absence.
