A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to elections; requiring that acceptable
2 voter identification be presented for a voter to obtain an
3 absentee ballot in person; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-3-118(a)(intro) and 22-9-104(a) by
9 creating a new paragraph (vi) are amended to read:

10

11 **22-3-118. Proof of identity.**

12

13 (a) Unless a voter is challenged pursuant to W.S.
14 22-15-101 through 22-15-109, and except as provided in W.S.

1 22-9-104(a)(vi) for an absentee ballot obtained in person
2 by the elector, no identification shall be required when:

3

4 **22-9-104. How to apply; information required.**

5

6 (a) A qualified elector may apply for an absentee
7 ballot either in person, in writing, or by telephone, by
8 furnishing the following information:

9

10 (vi) If obtained in person by the elector, the
11 elector shall provide acceptable identification as provided
12 in W.S. 22-1-102(a)(xxxix)(B).

14 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
