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1	(a) At the discretion of the commissioner and after
2	notice provided under subsection (d) of this section, any
3	insurer writing coverage for health care malpractice in
4	this state, by March 1 of each year, shall may be required
5	to file with the commissioner a report of all claims
6	against a health care provider and a report of all awards
7	or settlements given in cases against health care
8	providers. The report shall contain the following
9	information only for the preceding calendar year:

11	(d) The commissioner shall give insurers not less
12	than three (3) months notice if the information in
13	subsection (a) of this section will be required to be
14	reported to the commissioner.

16	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
