A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to defense forces and affairs; striking the
2 one-year employment requirement for a leave of absence for
3 military duty for state employees; and providing for an
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-11-108(b) is amended to read:

9

10 **19-11-108. Leave of absence for state, city or county**
11 **officers and employees; training programs.**

13 (b) Subject to the conditions prescribed in
14 paragraphs (c)(i) through (v) of this section, any officer
15 or employee of the state or any political subdivision,

1 municipal corporation or public agency of the state ~~who has~~
2 ~~been employed for one (1) year and~~ who is a member of the
3 national guard of any state or any other component of the
4 military forces of a state, a member of the reserve forces
5 of the United States or who is inducted into the military
6 service of the United States, is entitled to leave of
7 absence from his public office or employment without pay
8 but without loss of seniority, status, efficiency rating,
9 vacation, sick leave or other benefits while he is engaged
10 in active military training or service ordered or
11 authorized by proper authority pursuant to law exceeding
12 fifteen (15) days in any calendar year. Such leave is in
13 addition to any other military leave or vacation time to
14 which the officer or employee may be entitled by law if the
15 required military service is satisfactorily performed,
16 which is presumed unless the contrary is established.

18 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
