10 (c) Any person who violates paragraphs (b)(i) or (ii)

11 of this section is guilty of misdemeanor punishable by

12 imprisonment for not more than one (1) year, a fine of not

13 more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), or both. Any

14 person who violates paragraph (b)(iii) of this section is

15 quilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more

16 than ten (10) years, a fine of not more than ten thousand

17 dollars (\$10,000.00), or both.

19 (d) A person who uses an unmanned aircraft system

20 under one (1) or more of the exclusions specified in

21 subdivisions (a)(iii)(B)(II) through (IV) of this section

22 shall provide reasonable notice of the intended use of the

23 unmanned aircraft system at the penal institution or
