7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1.

11 appropriated ten million (a) There is dollars (\$10,000,000.00) from the general fund to the 12 Wyoming 13 department of transportation for the period beginning with 14 the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2028 to 15 be expended only for purposes of providing funds for school 16 crosswalk projects on state highways and for school

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counties in accordance with subsection (b) of this section and for administrative expenses in accordance with subsection (c) of this section. This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,

 $8\,$ 2028. It is the intent of the legislature that this

9 appropriation not be included in the standard budget of the

10 department of transportation for any immediately succeeding

11 fiscal biennium.

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13 (b) The department of transportation shall expend or 14 distribute funds appropriated under subsection (a) of this 15 section to cities, towns and counties in accordance with 16 the following:

18 (i) Funds shall only expended be by the department, cities, towns and counties on improvements to 19 20 crosswalks identified in a local transportation plan that support safe routes to school or that are located within 21 school zones where the speed limit is reduced in accordance 22 23 with W.S. 31-5-301(b)(i) or where the crosswalk is

1 immediately adjacent to a school facility. For purposes of

2 this paragraph, improvements to crosswalks shall include:

3

4 (A) Planning, design, construction and

5 installation of pedestrian overpasses;

6

7 (B) Planning, design, construction and

8 installation of pedestrian underpasses or tunnels;

9

10 (C) Improvements to existing school

11 crosswalks, including improvements to existing pedestrian

12 overpasses, pedestrian underpasses, signage, signals,

13 lighting and the roadway adjacent to school crosswalks.

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15 (ii) The department shall prioritize the

16 expenditure and distribution of funds for school crosswalks

17 in the following order:

19 (A) School crosswalks where a fatality has

20 occurred within the last two (2) years;

22 (B) School crosswalks where an injury or

3

23 other accident has occurred within the last two (2) years;

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2 (C) Any other school crosswalk where the

3 department determines that there is a need for an

4 improvement specified in paragraph (i) of this subsection;

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6 (D) Any school crosswalk identified in a

7 local transportation plan.

8

9 (iii) Projects for school crosswalks shall be

10 completed not later than June 30, 2028.

11

12 (c) Not more than two percent (2%) of the funds

13 appropriated in subsection (a) of this section may be used

14 by the department of transportation for administrative

15 expenses to administer this act. The distribution of funds

16 appropriated under this act shall be in the same manner as

17 the department currently administers the transportation

18 alternatives program.

1 Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon

2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

4 Constitution.
