10 **Section 1.** W.S. 28-5-101(b) is amended to read:

- 12 28-5-101. Schedule of compensation, per diem and

- 15 (b) Until such time as the amount is adjusted as
- 16 provided in this subsection, the amount to be received by

1 each member of the legislature for expenses shall be one

2 hundred nine dollars (\$109.00) one hundred fifty-five

3 dollars (\$155.00) per day. The amount shall be adjusted as

4 of July 1 of each year by the state auditor to an amount

5 equal to the most recent per diem rates established by the

United States general services administration for locations 6

within Wyoming. 7

11 There is appropriated one hundred twenty-five (a) thousand dollars (\$125,000.00) from the general fund to the 12 legislative service office for purposes of supplementing 13 the per diem provided to legislators as required by this 14

15 act.

17 is appropriated seventy-five thousand (b) There dollars (\$75,000.00) from the general fund to the state 18 19 auditor's office for purposes of supplementing the per diem 20 provided to members of any state board, commission, 21 council, authority or other state entity paid from the general fund whose rate of per diem is based upon the 22

4 (c) For members of any state board, commission,

amount of per diem paid to legislators as required by this

5 council, authority or other state entity whose rate of per

6 diem is based upon the amount of per diem paid to

7 legislators and is paid from a nongeneral fund source, to

8 the extent funds are available, there is appropriated from

9 those accounts and funds to those entities amounts

10 necessary to supplement the per diem provided to those

11 members as required by this act.

13 (d) The appropriations under this section shall be

14 for the period beginning with the effective date of this

15 act and ending June 30, 2024. The appropriations under

16 this section shall not be transferred or expended for any

17 other purposes and any unexpended, unobligated funds

18 remaining from the appropriations under this section shall

19 revert as provided by law on June 30, 2024.

21 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
