A BILL

1 ACT relating to agriculture, livestock and other AN 2 animals; amending the penalties for the construction or 3 maintenance of an unlawful wire fence; amending the civil liability standard for damage caused by an unlawful wire 4 fence from animals to livestock; limiting the shared costs 5 б of a partition fence between a subdivider and an adjoining 7 landowner; amending the liability of a subdivider for 8 livestock that enters onto subdivided land; making a conforming amendment; and providing for an effective date. 9 10 11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 12 11-28-106(b) 13 Section 11-28-103(a), 1. W.S. and 14 11-28-108(a) are amended to read: 15

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11-28-103. Constructing of unlawful wire fence;
 liability and penalty; reconstruction required; penalty for
 failure.

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(a) Any person who constructs or maintains 5 any unlawful wire fence contrary to this chapter, is liable in 6 a civil action for all damages to animals livestock that 7 may occur by reason of the unlawful enclosure. The owner of 8 any unlawful wire fence is guilty of a misdemeanor and 9 10 shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00) one 11 hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) nor more than twenty-five 12 dollars (\$25.00) seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), and for each subsequent offense the fine shall not be less than 13 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) seven hundred fifty dollars 14 (\$750.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) three 15 16 thousand dollars (\$3,000.00).

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18 11-28-106. Construction and maintenance of partition 19 fences.

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(b) For subdivisions as defined in W.S.
18-5-302(a)(vii), the subdivider shall be responsible for
the construction of a perimeter partition fence on any part

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1	of the subdivision adjacent to lands upon which livestock
2	can be legally run at large. The costs of the perimeter
3	partition fence shall be paid for by the parties in
4	accordance with subsection (a) of this section except an
5	adjoining landowner to a subdivision shall only be required
6	to pay for one-half (1/2) of the actual cost to construct
7	and maintain a lawful fence described in W.S. 11-28-102(a)
8	and (b). The subdivider shall pay any additional costs of
9	construction and maintenance of a perimeter partition fence
10	that exceed the requirements of a lawful fence. The
11	adjoining landowner shall not be liable for any damages
12	caused by, or arising from, livestock pastured on the
13	adjoining land that may breach the perimeter partition
14	fence or wander onto the subdivided land.
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16	11-28-108. Liability for breach into lawful enclosure
17	by animal; civil action or arbitration.
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19	(a) Any person owning or having in his possession or
20	charge any livestock or domesticated buffalo which breaches
21	into any lawful enclosure belonging to someone other than
22	the owner of the animal, is liable to the party sustaining
23	the injury for all damages sustained by reason of such

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breaching, except as provided in W.S. 11-28-106(b) for 1 2 liability regarding perimeter partition fences on 3 subdivisions. Damages may be recovered in a civil action 4 before any court having jurisdiction, or by arbitration, 5 each party to select a property holder and the two (2) arbitrators to select a third. The arbitrators shall be б sworn before a judge of a circuit court before entering 7 8 upon their duties. The arbitrators shall carefully examine the fence and assess the damage done, examine witnesses 9 10 under oath, one (1) of them to administer the oath to the 11 witnesses, and make a written report signed by at least two 12 (2) of the arbitrators, to the circuit court in the county in which the damage is sustained. The finding of the 13 arbitration, as provided for in this section, shall within 14 three (3) days after rendered, be filed with a judge of a 15 16 circuit court in the county where the trespass was 17 committed, who shall enter the cost upon his docket and proceed to issue execution therein as in other cases 18 19 originally commenced before him.
