11	(a) A health care facility that provides twenty-four

13	intermediate care facility, nursing care facility,
14	psychiatric care facility, residential rehabilitation
15	facility or assisted living facility shall allow visitation

1 visitation required under this section shall not apply to 2 persons involuntarily detained under W.S. 25-10-109 or 3 25-10-110 or adults who have been convicted of a crime and 4 are in the custody of the state or a local jurisdiction.

(b) A health care facility subject to subsection (a) 6 of this section may impose and enforce restrictions on 7 visitation that limit the number or age of visitors, limit 8 the location or time of visitation, require protective 9 10 equipment or impose requirements otherwise required under 11 W.S. 35-1-240 or by the centers for Medicaid and Medicare 12 services, the centers for disease control or the joint 13 commission on the accreditation of healthcare organizations. A health care facility shall provide a 14 15 written copy of its visitation policy to every person admitted to the facility or to that person's representative 16 17 and shall visibly post in the facility one (1) copy of the most current visitation restrictions imposed in accordance 18 19 with this subsection. The health care facility shall allow 20 the person receiving care or that person's representative 21 to designate persons as visitors or to prohibit some or all visitation under this section. 22
