7	enters into an agreement to lease buildings and facilities

The 2 lease agreement shall separately identify the amount to be 3 expended on the major maintenance of the building or 4 facility during the term of the lease. The amount of the 5 total lease agreement to be expended on the major maintenance shall be accounted for and reported separately 6 7 and shall not be transferred or expended for any purpose 8 other than major maintenance of the leased building or facility. No expenditure shall be made from the funds 9 10 dedicated for major maintenance of a leased facility 11 without the approval of the district or the charter school. The district shall be reimbursed for the lease payment of 12 the district or the charter school if the square footage of 13 the leased facility is not included within the district's 14 total square footage for purposes of major maintenance 15 computations 16 under W.S. 21-15-109, subject to the 17 following: 18 19 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2023.
