A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to limited liability companies; requiring  
2 reporting of specified owners of limited liability  
3 companies; providing a definition; and providing for an  
4 effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 17-29-209(a) is amended to read:

10 **17-29-209. Annual report for secretary of state.**

12 (a) Every limited liability company organized under  
13 the laws of this state and every foreign limited liability  
14 company which obtains a certificate of authority to  
15 transact and carry on business within this state shall file  
16 with the secretary of state on or before the first day of

1 the month of organization of every year a certification,  
2 under the penalty of perjury, by its treasurer or other  
3 fiscal agent setting forth its capital, property and assets  
4 located and employed in the state of Wyoming. The statement  
5 shall give the address of its principal office. If a  
6 beneficial owner of the limited liability company or  
7 foreign limited liability company is a trust, the statement  
8 shall include the identity of the trust and the identity  
9 and contact information of the trustees of the trust. On or  
10 before the first day of the month of organization of every  
11 year the limited liability company or foreign limited  
12 liability company shall pay to the secretary of state in  
13 addition to all other statutory taxes and fees a license  
14 fee based upon the sum of its capital, property and assets  
15 reported, of sixty dollars (\$60.00) or two-tenths of one  
16 mill on the dollar (\$.0002), whichever is greater. As used  
17 in this section, "beneficial owner" means a member of a  
18 limited liability company that owns fifty percent (50%) or  
19 more of the interests in the profits from the limited  
20 liability company.

1           **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
