A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; amending the  
2 offense of drug-induced homicide as specified; and  
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 6-2-108(a)(i), by amending and  
8 renumbering (ii) as (B) and by creating a new paragraph  
9 (ii) is amended to read:

11 **6-2-108. Drug induced homicide; penalty.**

13 (a) A person is guilty of drug induced homicide if:

14

15 (i) He:

1

2                    (A) Is an adult or is at least four (4)  
3 years older than the victim; and

4

5                    (ii)(B) He Violates W.S. 35-7-1031(a)(i) or  
6 (ii) or (b)(i) or (ii) by unlawfully delivering a  
7 controlled substance to a minor and that minor dies as a  
8 result of the injection, inhalation, ingestion or  
9 administration by any other means of any amount of that  
10 controlled substance.

11

12                    (ii) He violates W.S. 35-7-1031(a)(i) by  
13 unlawfully delivering fentanyl, heroin or methamphetamine  
14 to another person and that person dies as a result of the  
15 injection, inhalation, ingestion or administration by any  
16 other means of any amount of the fentanyl, heroin or  
17 methamphetamine.

19                    **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2023.
