### "Section 2.

- (a) There is appropriated eighty-seven million one hundred thousand dollars (\$87,100,000.00) to the department of revenue from the general fund to be distributed as follows:
- (i) An amount equal to the reduction in revenue attributable to the property tax assessment rate decrease under this act for the mills levied under W.S. 21-13-102(a), 21-13-201(a) and 21-13-303(a) to the public school foundation program account for the purpose of reimbursing the account;
- (ii) After accounting for the distribution under paragraph (i) of this subsection, the balance of the appropriation is appropriated for the purposes of reimbursing local governments for the reduction in revenue attributable to the property tax assessment rate decrease under this act. Reimbursements under this paragraph shall not include amounts reimbursed under paragraph (i) of this subsection. If the appropriation under this subsection is not sufficient to account for the total reduction in revenue, a pro rata amount shall be distributed by the department of revenue to local governments.
- (b) The appropriation under this section shall not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2026. The department of revenue shall calculate the reduction in revenue attributable to the property tax assessment rate decrease under this act for tax year 2025 to determine the reimbursement amounts. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning on the effective date of this this act and ending June 30, 2026. It is the intent of the legislature that this appropriation not be included in any standard budget for the 2027-2028 fiscal biennium."
