

## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0008

Commercial driver license-hazardous materials endorsement.

Sponsored by: Joint Transportation, Highways & Military  
Affairs Interim Committee

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; specifying that a driver  
2 who has attained eighteen (18) years of age may receive a  
3 hazardous materials endorsement for a commercial driver's  
4 license; requiring rulemaking; and providing for effective  
5 dates.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-7-304(a)(ii)(A) is amended to  
10 read:

11

12 **31-7-304. Issuance; classifications and endorsements.**

13

14 (a) Commercial driver's licenses may be issued with  
15 the following classifications and endorsements. The holder

1 of a valid commercial driver's license may drive all  
2 vehicles in the class for which that license is issued and  
3 all lesser classes of vehicles except motorcycles and  
4 vehicles which require a separate endorsement, unless the  
5 proper endorsement appears on the license:

7 (ii) The following driver's license endorsements  
8 are special authorizations permitting the driver to operate  
9 certain types of motor vehicles or transport certain types  
10 of cargo if the endorsement is displayed on the driver's  
11 license:

12

13 (A) "H" authorizes the operation of a  
14 vehicle transporting hazardous materials, provided that the  
15 licensed driver has attained the age of eighteen (18)  
16 years;

18 **Section 2.** The department of transportation shall  
19 promulgate any rules necessary to implement this act.

1           **Section 3.**

3           (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this  
4 section, this act is effective July 1, 2024.

5

6           (b) Sections 2 and 3 of this act are effective  
7 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a  
8 bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of  
9 the Wyoming Constitution.
