All other for the costs improvement, modification, operation and maintenance of school district 9 10 facilities used by the charter school shall be subject to negotiation between the charter school and the district 11 12 board and may be negotiated as an agreement separate from a 13 charter contract between the charter school and the 14 authorizer. 15 16 21-15-123.
