11 (c) The allegations of the petition shall be proved

12 by a preponderance of the evidence. If the court finds

13 that the vulnerable adult has been or is being abused,

14 neglected, exploited, intimidated or abandoned, or is

15 committing self neglect, that an emergency exists and that

16 the vulnerable adult lacks the capacity to consent to the

provision of services, the court may order the department 1 2 to provide protective services on an emergency basis. 3 court shall order only those services necessary to remove 4 the conditions creating the emergency and specifically designate the authorized services. The order 5 for emergency protective services shall remain in effect 6 7 for a period not to exceed seventy-two (72) hours, 8 excluding weekends and holidays fourteen (14) days. order may be extended for up to an additional thirty (30) 9 day period if the court finds that the extension is 10 11 necessary to remove the emergency. The vulnerable adult, 12 his agent, his court appointed representative or the department, through the attorney general or the district 13 attorney, may petition the court to set aside or modify the 14 15 order at any time.
