7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

9 Section 1.

- 11 (a) The forensic genetic genealogy pilot program is
- 12 hereby created. The division of criminal investigation
- 13 shall establish and administer this program for forensic
- 14 genetic genealogical DNA analyses and searches as set forth

15 in this section.

1 (b) The division may use funds made available to

2 operate the forensic genetic genealogy pilot program for

3 the following purposes:

5 (i) For forensic genetic genealogical DNA

6 analyses and searches to assist in generating leads for

7 criminal investigations or identifying human remains in

8 investigations conducted by the division pursuant to W.S.

9 9-1-618;

10

11 (ii) To award grants to law enforcement agencies

12 in this state for forensic genetic genealogical DNA

13 analyses and searches to assist in generating leads for

14 criminal investigations or identifying human remains in

15 investigations, according to an application process

16 established by the division.

18 (c) The forensic genetic genealogy pilot program

19 shall terminate, and no grants shall be awarded after, June

20 30, 2029. Grants awarded prior to June 30, 2029 may be

21 expended after the pilot program terminates.

1 (d) Nothing in this act shall be construed as a 2 restriction on the division using other available funding 3 to conduct forensic genetic genealogical DNA analyses and 4 searches. 5 6 Section 2. There is appropriated one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00) from the general fund to the 7 8 division of criminal investigation for the period beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2029. This appropriation 9 10 shall only be used to operate the forensic genetic genealogy pilot program created by section 1 of this act. 11 12 This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for 13 any other purpose. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this 14 15 appropriation shall not revert until June 30, 2029. 16

17 Section 3. The division of criminal investigation shall promulgate any rules necessary to administer this 18 19 act.

21 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2024.
