All monies in the account are continuously 15 appropriated to the office of the governor to be used for

law, including per diem, mileage and other administrative 1 expenses of the ENDOW executive council. Notwithstanding 2 3 W.S. 9-2-1008 and 9-4-207, funds in the account or 4 subaccounts of the account shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal period. Interest earned on funds in the account 5 shall be deposited to the account or appropriate 6 7 subaccount. Within the account shall be subaccounts. For 8 accounting and investment purposes only all subaccounts 9 shall be treated as separate accounts. The subaccounts are 10 as follows: 11 12 (ii) The broadband development subaccount. Funds within this subaccount may be expended as requested 13 by the Wyoming business council and approved by the 14 governor or his designee to: 15 16 17 (A) Provide funding for agreements entered into pursuant to W.S. 9-12-1501 through 9-12-1510; 18 19 (B) Provide the state's share of any 20 21 matching funds required for the state to receive federal 22 funds under any federal broadband program including, but
