(iv) Except as otherwise provided in W.S. 6 31-13-104(g), any towing and recovery service as defined by 7 8 W.S. 31-13-101(a)(xiv) shall request a title search report upon a form prescribed by the department of transportation 9 10 within five (5) business days after a towed vehicle has 11 remained in a recovery lot for more than five (5) business days. Upon receipt of the request, the department of 12 transportation shall make reasonable efforts to identify 13 the owner and any lienholders of record. The department of 14 transportation shall forward the information obtained to 15 the towing and recovery service within five (5) business 16 17 days of receipt of the request for any vehicle registered in Wyoming or within seven (7) business days of receipt of 18 19 the request for any vehicle registered in another 20 jurisdiction. Upon receipt of the information, the towing 21 and recovery service shall notify the lienholders of record 22 of the location of the vehicle within one (1) business day
