1 (b) The state, or any agency or political subdivision 2 of the state including all courts in the state, shall not 3 infringe the parental right as provided under this section 4 without demonstrating that the interest of the government as applied to the parent or child is a compelling state 5 interest addressed by the least restrictive means. 6 7 8 (c) The parental right as provided under this section shall also apply to any state or local education agency, 9 10 school district, board of trustees, commission or school 11 under title 21 of the Wyoming statutes regarding communication or disclosure to a parent about that parent's 12 13 child. 14 21-3-110.
