A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to education; reauthorizing the Wyoming

- 2 teacher shortage loan repayment program; modifying
- 3 eligibility requirements; making conforming amendments;
- 4 providing an appropriation; repealing a sunset date; and
- 5 providing for an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1**. W.S. 21-7-601(b)(i)(A), (B), (e), (g)(ii),
- 10 (n) and (p)(intro) is amended to read:

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- 12 21-7-601. Wyoming teacher shortage loan repayment
- 13 program; eligibility criteria; procedures; program

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14 reporting.

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1 2 (b) To qualify for a loan under this section, the 3 applicant shall first: 4 (i) Be enrolled in good standing in a teacher 5 education program at the University of Wyoming leading to: 6 7 8 (A) Certification as a special education, math, science or world language teacher; or 9 10 11 (B) Eligibility for an additional teaching 12 endorsement. to teach reading or English as a second language. 13 14 (e) A recipient of a loan under this section may 15 16 repay the loan without cash payment by teaching at least 17 fifty percent (50%) of his working hours as a teacher in special education, math, science, world language, reading 18 19 or English as a second language as a certified teacher in a 20 Wyoming public school as provided in subsection (f) of this 21 section. To qualify as repayment under this subsection,

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work shall be performed within the minimum amount of time

necessary to repay the loan, plus two (2) years, which

- 1 shall begin with the calendar month following the month in
- 2 which the student completed the academic program.

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4 (g) Any recipient of a loan under this section who 5 fails:

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7 (ii) To obtain employment in the targeted
8 occupation for which the person received the education
9 within two hundred forty (240) days after successfully
10 obtaining the appropriate certification, shall commence

11 cash repayment of the loan within two hundred eighty-five

12 (285) days after successfully obtaining the appropriate

13 certification;

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(n) The community college commission shall annually 15 16 review the loan program established under this section and report to the governor and the legislature in accordance 17 with W.S. 9-2-1014, regarding program results, funds 18 19 received and loans issued during the preceding academic 20 year, together with the status of all outstanding loan 21 commitments and repayments under the program. The report required under this subsection shall include information 22 submitted by the professional teaching standards board 23

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- 1 regarding the impact of the program on identified teacher
- 2 shortage areas shortages and recommendations for
- 3 modifications to the program, including funding levels, to
- 4 address other identified teacher shortage in targeted
- 5 areas.

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- 7 (p) Notwithstanding subsection (o) any other
- 8 provision of this section the law:

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10 **Section 2**. W.S. 21-7-601(o) is repealed.

- 14 (a) There is appropriated two million dollars
- 15 (\$2,000,000.00) from the general fund to the Wyoming
- 16 community college commission for the period beginning July
- 17 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026. This appropriation shall
- 18 be used for the loan program established by W.S. 21-7-601,
- 19 as amended by this act, and as authorized by subsection (b)
- 20 of this section. This appropriation shall not be
- 21 transferred or expended for any other purpose and any
- 22 unexpended, unobligated funds remaining from this
- 23 appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30,

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1 2026. It is the intent of the legislature that this

2 appropriation be included in the standard budget request

3 for the commission for the immediately succeeding fiscal

4 biennium.

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6 (b) Not more than fifteen percent (15%) of the amount

7 appropriated under this section shall be used by the

8 Wyoming community college commission for the administration

9 of this program, including expenses of the commission, loan

10 administration fees and marketing costs to advertise

11 availability of the program.

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13 **Section 4.** This act is effective immediately upon

14 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

15 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

16 Constitution.
