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    leaders, shall appoint members to the respective standing
    committees in accordance with the rules of each body.

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14	(a) The senate and the house of representatives

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17	(i) Review any federal actions, as approved by
18	the management council pursuant to subsection (b) of this
19	section, to determine if the sovereignty of the state of
20	Wyoming and the powers, rights and liberties of its
21	citizens, as legally defined during the ratification
22	debates of the several states in ratifying the United

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States Constitution of 1787, are being infringed upon or
 diminished;

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4 (ii) Determine and make findings as to which 5 federal actions are not consistent with the enumerated 6 roles, responsibilities and powers of the United States 7 government in the United States constitution. This duty 8 shall be exercised without regard for any United States 9 supreme court or other judicial decisions that attempt to 10 interpret federal actions;

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12 (iii) Report to and submit recommendations to 13 the legislature, including sponsoring legislation, 14 consistent with any determinations and findings made by the 15 committee concerning the constitutionality of federal 16 actions.

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18 (b) The management council shall approve specific 19 studies of federal actions under subsection (a) of this 20 section upon the committee's request and in accordance with 21 W.S. 28-8-104(b).

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1 (c) For purposes of this section, "federal action" 2 means all new and existing federal laws, resolutions, 3 rules, regulations, decrees, orders, mandates, executive 4 orders and any other federal dictate having the force and 5 effect of law.

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7 Section 2. The president of the senate and the 8 speaker of the house of representatives shall appoint 9 members to the federal review joint and standing committee 10 not later than January 6, 2025.

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12 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 13 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 14 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 15 Constitution.
