2	involved in an accident resulting <u>that</u> results in injury to
3	or <u>the</u> death of any person shall immediately stop the <u>his</u>
4	vehicle at the scene of the accident or as close thereto as
5	possible <u>,</u> but and shall then forthwith return to and in
6	every event shall remain at the scene of the accident until
7	he has fulfilled the requirements of W.S. 31-5-1103. Every
8	stop shall be made without obstructing traffic more than is
9	necessary.
