W.S. 11-23-102 by creating a new 10 subsection (c), 11-23-105 and 11-23-203 are amended to 11 read: 12 13 11-23-102. Only inspected livestock to be 14 slaughtered; record of cattle slaughtered.

1	(c) If a hide is sold to a hide buyer, the bill of
2	sale shall accompany the hide and shall be available for
3	inspection by an authorized Wyoming brand inspector,
4	department inspector, sheriff or deputy sheriff during
5	regular business hours for not less than two (2) years from
6	the date of the sale of the hide.

8	11-23-105. Penalties.

10	Any person violating any provision of W.S. $\frac{11-23-101}{23-101}$
11	through 11-23-104 11-23-102 and 11-23-103 shall be fined
12	not less than seven hundred seventy-five dollars (\$775.00)
13	or more than one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00),
14	or imprisoned for not more than one (1) year, or both.

17	kept; contents; inspection by sheriff.

19	Every hide buyer in this state shall keep a true record of
20	all hides and pelts purchased by him, showing the name of
21	the seller of the hides or pelts, the date of purchase and
22	all brands and other identification marks on the hides and
23	pelts for not less than two (2) years from the date of

1 purchase. The record shall be open for inspection by the sheriff or his deputy in his county and any livestock 2 3 inspector. 4 5 Section 2. W.S. 11-23-101 and 11-23-104 are repealed. б Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 7 8 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 9 10 Constitution. 11 12 (END)
