4	(b) The department shall prepare budget requests on
5	behalf of and subject to the approval of the state fair
6	board for the conduct and management of the annual state
7	fair and for the operation and maintenance of the state
8	fairgrounds, including building and facility needs for
9	major maintenance and repair. The director is responsible
10	for the proper disbursement of all funds appropriated for
11	the annual state fair and fairgrounds.

13	(c) The state fair board shall:

15	(vii) To the extent establishing a subcommittee
16	would aid in executing the annual state fair, appoint a
17	subcommittee of state fair board members to plan, conduct
