1 AN ACT relating to trade and commerce; amending the Wyoming 2 Stable Token Act to allow for investments in cash and government securities as specified; authorizing the Wyoming 3 stable token commission to issue different types 4 and 5 amounts of stable tokens and to contract with financial б service providers; requiring reporting only for fully 7 reserved stable tokens as specified; making conforming amendments to criminal history records statutes; 8 and 9 providing for an effective date.

9 Wyoming stable token trust (a) The account is created. The commission shall deposit all funds received 10 for the issuance of Wyoming stable tokens into the account. 11 12 Funds within the account received from the sale of Wyoming stable tokens shall be held in trust to support the 13 redemption of Wyoming stable tokens, and shall not be 14 expended for any other purpose but shall be expended to 15 16 redeem Wyoming stable tokens. The commission shall invest 17 funds within the account exclusively in cash, United States treasury bills securities with a maturity of one (1) year 18 19 or less or United States treasury security repurchase 20 agreements with a term of one (1) month or less. By creation of this trust, the state does not create any 21 fiduciary duty to token holders. earnings 22 Investment generated by the funds in the account may be deposited in 23
