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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 27-3-505(a) is amended to read:

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- 10 27-3-505. Adjustment for noncharged and ineffectively
- 11 charged benefits; adjustment for positive and negative fund
- 12 balance; computations; exception; maximum rate.

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- 14 (a) An adjustment factor for noncharged and
- 15 ineffectively charged benefits shall be computed to the
- 16 fourth decimal by dividing the total noncharged and

1 ineffectively charged benefits to all employers' experience 2 rating accounts during the experience rating period ending 3 June 30 by the total taxable wages payable during the 4 experience period and added to the rate provided by W.S. 27-3-503. The total taxable wages payable under this 5 subsection shall not include wages payable by employers 6 7 electing payments instead of contributions under W.S. 8 27-3-509. Sixty percent (60%) Of this adjustment factor, 9 twenty percent (20%) shall be allocated to the unemployment 10 compensation fund, . Forty percent (40%) of this adjustment 11 factor sixty percent (60%) shall be allocated to the 12 employment support fund created by W.S. 27-3-211 and twenty percent (20%) shall be allocated to the workforce 13 development training fund established in W.S. 9-2-2604. 14 15 16 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2024.
