1 AN ACT relating to taxation and revenue; increasing the amount of exemption for veterans for ad valorem taxation; 2 requiring rulemaking; specifying applicability; providing 3 an appropriation; and providing for effective dates. 4 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: б 7 8 Section 1. W.S. 39-13-105(b) is amended to read: 9 10 39-13-105. Exemptions. 11 12 (b) The exemption for veterans is limited to an annual exemption of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) six 13 14 thousand dollars (\$6,000.00) of assessed value. 15

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3 (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, there 4 is appropriated eight million two hundred thousand dollars 5 (\$8,200,000.00) from the general fund state to the treasurer to be expended only for purposes of providing б reimbursements to counties for the veterans' tax exemption 7 8 as provided by W.S. 39-13-102(k). This appropriation shall 9 not be transferred or expended for any other purpose and 10 any unobligated, unexpended funds remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 11 12 2027.

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14 (b) The appropriation in subsection (a) of this section shall be reduced by one dollar (\$1.00) for every 15 16 one dollar (\$1.00) appropriated to the state treasurer 17 during the 2024 budget session in excess of eleven million five hundred forty-five thousand eight hundred thirty-nine 18 19 dollars (\$11,545,839.00) purposes of for providing 20 reimbursements to counties under W.S. 39-13-102(k).

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(c) It is the intent of the legislature that theappropriation in subsection (a) of this section be included

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1 in the state treasurer's standard budget for the 2 immediately succeeding fiscal biennium. 3 4 **Section 3.** This act shall apply to ad valorem tax assessed on and after January 1, 2025. 5 6 7 Section 4. The department of revenue shall promulgate 8 all rules necessary to implement the provisions of this 9 act. 10 Section 5. 11 12 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this 13 section, this act is effective June 1, 2025. 14 15 (b) Sections 4 and 5 of this act are effective 16 17 immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of 18 19 the Wyoming Constitution. 20 21 (END)

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
