4	Article 1, Section 29. Rights of aliens.

6	(a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this
7	section, no distinction shall ever be made by law between
8	resident aliens and citizens as to the possession, taxation,
9	enjoyment and descent of property.

11	(b) Foreign adversaries of the United States and
12	prohibited foreign entities as determined by the legislature
13	that pose a threat to national security shall not be entitled
14	to possession, enjoyment or descent of property, including
15	any interest in real property or real estate and any surface,
16	subsurface, airspace or mineral interest in this state.

That the Secretary of State shall endorse 2 the following statement on the proposed amendment: 3 4 The adoption of this amendment would specify that foreign adversaries of the United States and prohibited foreign 5 entities as determined by the legislature that pose a threat 6 7 to national security shall not be entitled to possession, 8 taxation, enjoyment or descent of property, including any 9 interest in real property or real estate and any surface, 10 subsurface, airspace or mineral interest in this state. 11
