8 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-13-310(a)(ix) is amended to read:

- 12 (a) To ensure revenues available to each district are
 13 uniformly sufficient to enable compliance with the uniform
 14 standards for educational programs prescribed under W.S.

1 21-9-101 and 21-9-102 and to secure state board

2 accreditation of educational programs under W.S.

3 21-2-304(a)(ii), the revenues specified under this

4 subsection shall be deemed state revenues and shall be

5 considered in determining the amount to be distributed to

6 each district under W.S. 21-13-311. A district shall make

7 an annual computation of the following revenues:

9 (ix) The amount of tuition paid to the district 10 during the previous school year, including any amount 11 charged under W.S. 21-4-501 and any amount assessed in

12 excess of the costs incurred for adult education programs,

13 summer school programs, programs provided under an

14 agreement for cooperative educational programs under W.S.

15 21-20-101 through 21-20-111 and any amount assessed for

16 programs and services for children with disabilities, but

17 excluding any tuition assessed by a district for the

18 provision of distance education programs to participating

19 nonresident students pursuant to W.S. 21-13-330;
