## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to campaign finance; repealing restrictions
- 2 on organizations making independent expenditures to
- 3 advocate the election or defeat of a candidate; conforming
- 4 state law to a United State Supreme Court ruling; and
- 5 providing for an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-25-102(a) and (b) and by creating
- 10 a new subsection (k) are amended to read:

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2 22-25-102. Contribution of funds or election 2 assistance restricted; limitation on contributions; right

to communicate; civil penalty.

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(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, no 5 6 organization of any kind including a corporation, 7 partnership, trade union, professional association or civic, fraternal or religious group or other profit or 8 nonprofit entity except a political party, political action 9 committee or candidate's campaign committee organized under 10 11 W.S. 22-25-101, directly or indirectly through any officer, 12 member, director or employee, shall contribute funds, other 13 items of value or election assistance directly to aid, 14 promote or prevent the nomination or election of any 15 candidate or group of candidates. or to aid or promote the interests, success or defeat of any political party. No 16 person shall solicit or receive a payment or contribution 17 18 from an organization prohibited from making contributions under this subsection. 19

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(b) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
22 only a natural person, political party, or a political
23 action committee or a candidate's campaign committee

organized under W.S. 22-25-101 shall contribute funds or election assistance in order to aid, promote or prevent the nomination or election of directly to any candidate or group of candidates., or in order to aid or promote the

5 interests, success or defeat of any political party. No

6 person shall solicit or receive a political payment or

7 contribution from any source other than a natural person,

8 political party, political action committee or candidate's

9 campaign committee organized under W.S. 22-25-101.

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11 The prohibitions in this section shall not be (k) 12 construed to prohibit any organization of any kind 13 including a corporation, partnership, trade union, 14 professional association or civic, fraternal or religious group or other profit or nonprofit entity from exercising 15 16 its first amendment rights to make independent expenditures for speech expressly advocating the election or defeat of a 17 18 candidate.

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Section 2. This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
