AN ACT relating to county commissions; providing authority 1 to create county commissioner districts in response to 2 3 court order; providing terms of county commissioners subject to districting; and providing for an effective 4 5 date. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8 9 Section 1. W.S. 18-3-501 by creating a new subsection 10 (k) is amended to read: 11 18-3-501. Composition; election for increasing the 12 number; term; quorum; election for districting; procedures. 13

2	(k) If required to do so pursuant to a final court
3	order, the board of county commissioners may by resolution
4	devise a districting plan dividing the county into any
5	number of districts necessary to meet the requirements of
6	the court order. A districting plan devised under this
7	subsection may include single member districts in which the
8	candidates must reside and which are apportioned by
9	population, districts in which candidates are elected at
10	large, or any combination of districts in which candidates
11	must reside and are apportioned by population or are
12	elected at large. A court ordered districting plan shall
13	not be subject to a vote of the electors. Commissioners in
14	office on the effective date of the districting plan shall
15	serve the county at large until the regular expiration of
16	their term. Additional offices created under this
17	subsection shall be filled by appointment by the current
18	county commission and thereafter shall be filled at the
19	general election next following the effective date of the
20	districting plan. Any commissioner elected after the
21	effective date of the districting plan shall meet the
22	requirements for the district from which he is elected.
