## A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to public works contracts; amending
- 2 definitions; extending residency requirements to two years;
- 3 modifying limitations on subcontracting; granting
- 4 rulemaking authority; providing for penalties; and
- 5 providing for an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 9 **Section 1.** W.S. 16-6-101(a)(i), by creating a new
- 10 paragraph (iii) and by renumbering (iii) as (iv), 16-6-103
- 11 and 16-6-120 are amended to read:

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13 **16-6-101. Definitions.** 

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1 (a) As used in this act: 2 3 (i) "Resident" means a person, partnership, limited partnership, registered limited partnership, 4 registered limited liability company or corporation 5 6 registered with the Wyoming secretary of state and 7 certified as a resident by the department of employment prior to bidding upon the contract or responding to a 8 9 request for proposal, subject to the following criteria: 10 11 (A) Any person who has been a resident of 12 the state for one (1) year two (2) years or more 13 immediately prior to bidding upon the contract or 14 responding to a request for proposal; or 15 16 (B) A partnership, association, partnership, registered limited partnership, registered 17 limited liability company or corporation, each member or 18 shareholder of which has been a resident of the state for 19 one (1) year two (2) years or more immediately prior to 20 21 bidding upon the contract or responding to a request for

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proposal;

1 (C) A corporation organized under the laws 2 of the state: 3 (I) With at least fifty percent (50%) of the issued and outstanding shares of stock in the 4 corporation owned by persons who have been residents of the 5 state for one (1) year two (2) years or more prior to 6 7 bidding upon the contract or responding to a request for proposal; , and 8 9 10 (II) Which maintains has maintained 11 its principal office and place of business within the state 12 for two (2) years or more, and 13 14 (III) The president of the corporation 15 has been a resident of the state for one (1) year two (2) 16 years or more immediately prior to bidding upon the contract or responding to a request for proposal. + 17 18 19 (D) A corporation organized under the laws 20 of the state which has been in existence in the state for one (1) year two (2) years or more and whose president has 21 22 been a resident of the state for one (1) year two (2) years 23 or more immediately prior to bidding upon the contract or

1 responding to a request for proposal and maintains its 2 principal office and place of business within the state. If

3 at least fifty percent (50%) of the issued and outstanding

4 shares of stock in the corporation are owned by

5 nonresidents, shares of the corporation shall:

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7 (I) Have been acquired by nonresidents

8 one (1) year two (2) years or more immediately prior to

9 bidding upon the contract or responding to a request for

10 proposal; or

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12 (E) A limited partnership organized under

13 the laws of the state and which maintains its principal

14 office and place of business in the state and the general

15 partners of which have been residents of the state for at

16 least one (1) year two (2) years or more immediately prior

21 partnership organized under the laws of the state and which

22 maintains its principal office and place of business in the

23 state and each member of which has been a resident of the

state for one (1) year two (2) years or more immediately 1 2 prior to bidding upon the contract or responding to a 3 request for proposal; 4 5 (G) A limited liability company organized under the laws of the state and which maintains its 6 7 principal office and place of business in the state and the 8 managing members or the appointed managers of which have 9 been residents of the state for one (1) year two (2) years or more immediately prior to bidding upon the contract or 10 11 responding to a request for proposal; or 12 13 (J) A corporation organized under the laws 14 of any state which has been in existence for two (2) years 15 or more and is publicly traded and registered under Section 16 13 or 15(d) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 for one (1) or more classes of its shares, and: 17 18 19 (I) Has continuously maintained a 20 principal place of business within the state for two (2) 21 years or more; 22

1	(II) Has continuously employed not
2	less than fifteen (15) full-time Wyoming resident employees
3	within the state;

5	(III) Has paid worker's compensation
6	and unemployment taxes in Wyoming for at least two (2)
7	years and is in good standing with Wyoming worker's
8	compensation and department of employment at the time the
9	bid or request for proposal is submitted.
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11	(iii) "Resident employee" means any person who:
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13	(A) Is employed by a business bidding on a
14	state contract or responding to a state request for
15	proposal;
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17	(B) Is a citizen of the United States; and
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19	(C) Has resided in Wyoming for at least two
20	(2) years immediately prior to the bid on the contract or
21	the response to the request for proposal.

         16-6-103. Limitation on subcontracting by resident
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    contractors.
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    A successful resident bidder shall not subcontract more
    than thirty percent (30%) twenty percent (20%) of the work
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    covered by his contract to nonresident contractors.
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         16-6-120. Rulemaking; penalties; enforcement.
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         (a) The department of employment shall promulgate
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    rules and regulations required to enforce this act.
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         (b) A person, partnership, association, limited
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    partnership, registered limited partnership, registered
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    limited liability company or corporation and any officers
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    or member thereof that intentionally falsifies information
    under this act shall be fined seven <a href="hundred-fifty-dollars">hundred fifty dollars</a>
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    ($750.00) for each violation for each day during which the
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    violation continues and shall be barred from bidding on any
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state contract or submitting any request for proposal on

- 1 any state project for not less than one (1) year from the
- 2 date the violation is corrected.

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- 4 (c) The department of employment is authorized and
- 5 directed to enforce W.S. 16-6-101 through 16-6-206.

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- 7 **Section 2.** W.S. 16-6-101(a)(i)(H) and (ii) is
- 8 repealed.

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Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2011.
