trustees of a school or community college district, shall 1 2 be filled by the governing body, or as otherwise provided 3 in this section, by appointment of a temporary successor. to The person appointed shall serve until a successor for 4 the remainder of the unexpired term is elected at the next 5 general election and takes office on the first Monday of 6 7 the following January. Provided, if a vacancy in a four (4) year term of office occurs in the term's second or 8 9 subsequent years after the first day for filing an application for nomination pursuant to W.S. 22-5-209, the 10 11 no election to fill the vacancy shall be held and the temporary successor appointed shall serve until the first 12 13 Monday in January following the second general election 14 thereafter the remainder of the unexpired term. The 15 following apply: 16 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2011. 17 18
