13 reconnaissance study of whether to create a Wyoming health

(a) The governor shall conduct an initial

- 1 insurance exchange, hereinafter referred to as "the 2 exchange," as provided in the Patient Protection and
- 3 Affordable Care Act, P.L. 111-148, and the Health Care and
- 4 Education Reconciliation Act of 2010, P.L. 111-152,
- 5 hereinafter referred to collectively as "the health care
- 6 reform acts."

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- 8 (b) The governor shall designate a study oversight
- 9 task force, which may be a state agency, more than one (1)
- 10 state agency or an ad hoc task force created by the
- 11 governor to conduct the study.

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- 13 (c) The oversight task force shall have the authority
- 14 to contract with experts and consultants as may be useful
- 15 in conducting the study.

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17 (d) The study shall:

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- 19 (i) Recommend whether the state should decide to
- 20 proceed or not to proceed with the development of the
- 21 exchange;

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1 (ii) If the recommendation is that the state 2 should proceed with the development of the exchange, provide a work plan for the development of the exchange and 3 identify any legislation needed to implement the exchange 4 during the 2012 legislative budget session or subsequent 5 legislative sessions; 6 7 (iii) Recommend whether the state should proceed 8 with the development of the exchange or defer the decision 9 until 2013. If a deferral is recommended, the study shall 10 11 identify the additional work needed before a final decision 12 can be made; 13 14 (iv) Evaluate whether the exchange will help the operation of the private marketplace in health insurance by 15 16 helping people comparison shop for health insurance and by reducing the marketing cost for health insurance. 17 The 18 study shall identify any additional work needed to facilitate these goals, if they are feasible; 19 20 21 Consider experience (v)the of Utah and 22 Massachusetts in developing and operating health insurance

exchanges, with primary attention being given to the Utah 1 2 experience; 3 (vi) Evaluate whether the exchange should offer 4 the full scope of services that the Utah exchange provides 5 or whether a more limited scope of services is appropriate; 6 7 8 (vii) Recommend whether Wyoming should proceed with the development of a health insurance exchange if the 9 related provisions in the health care reform acts are 10 11 repealed;

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13 (viii) Evaluate whether there is a reasonable 14 opportunity for successful litigation to prevent the federal government from proceeding with a health insurance 15 exchange serving Wyoming if Wyoming decides not to create a 16 Wyoming health insurance exchange or creates an exchange 17 with a limited scope not meeting the requirements of the 18 health care reform acts. The study shall also evaluate 19 whether the operation of a federal exchange would do 20 sufficient harm to the people of Wyoming to justify that 21 22 litigation;

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(ix) Evaluate whether an exchange can be used to facilitate the sale of health insurance across state lines and whether a decision by Wyoming to opt out of the Medicaid program or other provisions of national health insurance reform would affect the ability of other states

6 to join with Wyoming in the sale of insurance across state

7 lines.

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9 (e) A preliminary or interim study report shall be
10 provided to the joint labor, health and social services
11 interim committee by October 1, 2011.

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13 (f) There is appropriated five thousand dollars 14 (\$5,000.00) from the general fund to the governor's office. This appropriation shall be for the period beginning with 15 the effective date of this act and ending June 30, 2012. 16 This appropriation shall only be expended for the purpose 17 18 of conducting the study and preparing the report required by this act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, 19 this appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for 20 any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds 21 remaining from this appropriation shall revert as provided 22 by law on June 30, 2012. This appropriation shall not be 23

1 included in the governor's 2012 supplemental budget request

2 or the 2013-2014 standard biennial budget request.

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4 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon

5 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

6 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

7 Constitution.
