13 **26-2-131.** Immunity from liability.

2	(d) Any person or agency who knows or has reasonable
3	cause to believe that an insurance unfair trade practice or
4	insurance fraud is being committed may report the
5	information immediately to a law enforcement agency and the
6	commissioner. Anyone who in good faith makes a report
7	pursuant to this subsection is immune from civil liability
8	for making the report.

10	(e) Any person or agency who knows or has reasonable
11	cause to believe that insurance fraud has been committed is
12	immune from civil liability for furnishing any information
13	relating to the suspected fraud to law enforcement
14	agencies.

16	26-13-202. Penalties.
