6	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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8	Section 1. W.S. 31-2-215(b) and by creating new
9	subsection (e) is amended to read:

Application for license 1 (b) plates under subsectionsubsections (a) and (e) of this section shall be 2 annually made to the county treasurer as provided by this 3 article, except application shall be made not less than 4 5 thirty (30) days before the last day of the applicant's annual registration month. Application forms 6 shall be 7 available at all county treasurer's offices. The department may prepare any special forms and issue any rules and 8 regulations necessary to carry out this section. 9 10 11 In lieu of the disabled veterans plate described (e) in subsection (a) of this section, a veteran who qualifies 12 for a special license plate under this section may select 13 14 to receive any distinctive license plate authorized by this chapter for which the veteran qualifies and which is 15 related to service in the military. Application for the 16 license plate selected shall be made pursuant to subsection 17 (b) of this section and may require verification by the 18

19 Wyoming veterans' commission as otherwise required by this

20 <u>chapter.</u> Unless otherwise provided by law, any veteran
21 <u>applying for a license plate under this subsection shall be</u>
22 <u>responsible for payment of the registration fees prescribed</u>

23 by W.S. 31-3-101 and no additional fee shall be charged.

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1	Unless otherwise prohibited, a license plate issued under
2	this subsection may be placed upon a motorcycle.

4	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2011.
