## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the secretary of state; authorizing the 2 secretary of state to refuse to accept documents for 3 filing; authorizing the secretary of state to issue cease and desist orders; providing for notice and appeal; 4 5 authorizing the secretary of state to cause administrative forfeiture of authority of limited liability companies for 6 7 failure to maintain a registered agent; repealing secretary 8 of state authority to be appointed agent for service of 9 process for foreign limited partnerships; and providing for 10 an effective date.

12 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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Section 1. W.S. 9-1-308 is created to read:

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3 9-1-308. Powers and duties; refusal to file

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6 (a) The secretary of state may refuse to accept

7 documents for filing for up to five (5) years from any

8 person or any entity if that person or entity:

documents; cease and desist orders.

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10 (i) Has filed any document with the secretary of

11 state pursuant to Title 17 or Title 34 of Wyoming Statutes

12 that contained any statement which was, in light of the

13 circumstances under which it was made, intentionally or

14 knowingly fictitious or fraudulent with respect to any

15 material fact;

17 (ii) Makes or uses any false writing or document

18 knowing it to contain any materially false, fictitious or

19 fraudulent statement or entry with the expectation that a

20 person will rely on it to their detriment; or

21

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1 (iii) Is the subject of, an agent of or acting

2 on behalf of the subject of any order of the secretary of

3 state or any similar order issued in another jurisdiction.

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5 (b) The secretary of state may issue a cease and

6 desist order to any person or entity engaging in any

7 practice described in paragraphs (a)(i) and (ii) of this

8 section or any person or entity qualifying under paragraph

9 (a) (iii) of this section.

11 (c) Upon issuance of a cease and desist order under

12 subsection (b) of this section, the secretary of state

13 shall serve upon the person affected by the order, by

14 registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, to

15 the person's last known address, an order specifically

16 stating the acts complained of and requiring the person to

17 immediately cease and desist from the act, methods or

18 practices stated.

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20 (d) Any refusal to accept documents under subsection

21 (a) of this section and any order issued under subsection

22 (b) of this section is subject to the notice and appeal

- 1 provisions of the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act,
- 2 W.S. 16-3-101 through 16-3-115.

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4 **Section 2.** W.S. 17-29-705(a) is amended to read:

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6 17-29-705. Administrative forfeiture of authority and 7 articles of organization.

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9 If any limited liability company's company is 10 without a registered agent has filed its resignation with 11 the secretary of state and the limited liability company 12 has not replaced its registered agent and or registered 13 office for any reason, it shall be deemed to be transacting 14 business within this state without authority and to have forfeited any franchises, rights or privileges acquired 15 under the laws thereof and the forfeiture shall be made 16 effective in the following manner. The secretary of state 17 shall mail by certified mail a notice of its failure to 18 comply with aforesaid provisions. Unless compliance is made 19 within sixty (60) days of the delivery of notice, the 20 limited liability company shall be deemed defunct and to 21 have forfeited its articles of organization acquired under 22 the laws of this state. Provided, that any defunct limited 23

1	liability	company	may	at	any	time	within	two	(2)	years
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- after the forfeiture of its articles of organization or 2
- certificate of authority, in the manner herein provided, be 3
- revived and reinstated, by filing the necessary statement 4
- under this act and paying a reinstatement fee established 5
- 6 by the secretary of state by rule, together with a penalty
- 7 of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00). The reinstatement
- fee shall not exceed the costs of providing the 8
- reinstatement service. The limited liability company shall 9
- retain its registered name during the two (2) year 10
- 11 reinstatement period under this section.

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13 **Section 3.** W.S. 17-14-1002(a)(v) is repealed.

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- 15 Section 4. This act is effective immediately upon
- 16 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
- 17 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
- Constitution. 18
