Administration of districts by district 4 5 boards; number and qualifications of members; term; filling 6 of vacancies; removal. 7 8 For directors appointed by a board of county (C) 9 commissioners, the county commissioners may remove the 10 director for just cause without a public hearing unless the 11 director requests a public hearing. 12 13 18-5-103. Appointment of county planning commission; 14 composition; powers and duties generally; removal. 15 16 (d) The county commissioners may remove any member of 17 the county planning commission for just cause without a 18 public hearing unless the trustee requests a public 19 hearing. (a) Each board of county commissioners of any county 1 2 owning, constructing or acquiring any museum or collection 3 of exhibits shall appoint a board of trustees for the museum or collection composed of five (5) electors of the 4 5 county. The initial board of trustees shall be appointed as follows: one (1) member for a one (1) year term, two (2) 6 7 for a two (2) term and two (2) for a three (3) year term, with each term commencing on July 1 of the year of 8 9 appointment. Thereafter the terms shall be three (3) years. Vacancies shall be filled for unexpired terms. 10 11 12 (b) The county commissioners may remove any member of 13 the board of trustees for just cause without a public 14 hearing unless the trustee requests a public hearing.

15 <u>Vacancies on the board of trustees shall be filled by the</u> 16 <u>county commissioners for the balance of the unexpired term</u> 17 <u>created by the vacancy.</u>

22 <u>(a)</u> Following the creation of a solid waste disposal 23 district the board of county commissioners shall appoint

not less than three (3) nor more than nine (9) residents of 1 2 the district to constitute the governing board of the district. Appointees shall serve a term of three (3) years 3 and may be reappointed for three (3) additional terms. 4 5 Terms of office shall be staggered. The governing board may exercise all powers granted to cities and towns by W.S. 6 7 15-1-103(a)(xxi) and (xl) and shall adopt rules and regulations in managing the disposal of solid wastes within 8 9 the district. Violation of a rule or regulation of the governing board requiring disposal of solid wastes in 10 11 designated sites constitutes a misdemeanor punishable upon 12 conviction by a fine not to exceed seven hundred fifty 13 dollars (\$750.00) or imprisonment not exceeding six (6) 14 months or both. A governing board may also enforce its rules and regulations by appropriate legal proceedings and 15 16 expend and generate revenue relative to the purpose of a 17 solid waste disposal district. The governing board may 18 permit persons or entities not included within the district to utilize the facilities of the district. The governing 19 20 board may impose fees upon persons or entities included within or outside of the district for the privilege of 21 22 utilizing the facilities of the district at rates 23 established by the governing board and any revenue

1 generated in this manner shall only be used to operate the 2 district.

4 (b) The county commissioners may remove any member of 5 the governing board for just cause without a public hearing unless the member requests a public hearing. Vacancies on 6 7 the governing board shall be filled by the county 8 commissioners for the balance of the unexpired term created 9 by the vacancy. 10 11 35-1-302. Organization of units; membership of 12 boards; removal. 13 14 (d) The governing body which appointed the member of 15 the board may remove that member of the board for just 16 cause without a public hearing unless the member requests a 17 public hearing. Vacancies on the board shall be filled by 18 the governing body for the balance of the unexpired term 19 created by the vacancy. 20 21 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2012. 22 23
