Hospital districts-staggered terms.

## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to hospital districts; providing for five 2 year terms for board members after initial staggered terms; 3 and providing for an effective date. 4 5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 6 7 Section 1. W.S. 18-8-104(a) is amended to read: 8 9 18-8-104. Hospital generally under control of board 10 of trustees; appointment, powers and duties of trustees; incorporation; use of funds for erection of hospital; term 11 12 of lease; consolidation of hospitals; acquisition of land;

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removal of board member; filling of vacancies.

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The erection, management and control of the 2 (a) county memorial hospital, county memorial hospital fund and 3 all property and funds received for the benefit of the 4 hospital shall be by a board of trustees composed of at 5 least five (5) but not more than eleven (11) competent and 6 7 responsible citizens of the county appointed by the board of county commissioners. The number of members of any 8 9 board of trustees shall be an odd number determined by the county commissioners. The first board of trustees, or 10 11 additional members to a board of trustees, as soon as 12 appointed shall draw lots for the purpose of determining 13 the term of each member of the board. Up to two (2) members 14 of the original board or additional members of the board shall serve for a term of one (1) year, up to two (2) for a 15 term of two (2) years, up to two (2) for a term of three 16 17 (3) years, up to two (2) for a term of four (4) years and up to two (2) for a term of five (5) years after their 18 appointment. Terms thereafter shall be five (5) years, 19 consecutively staggered. Each trustee shall serve until 20 the first Monday of July following the expiration of their 21 term and the board of county commissioners annually at 22 23 their meeting in June shall appoint a successor to the

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trustee or trustees whose term expires. As soon as the 1 2 original board has determined the terms of its members they shall organize by electing a president, secretary and 3 treasurer of the board. As soon as they are organized they 4 shall file with the county clerk and the secretary of state 5 6 a certificate showing their organization, for which filing 7 fee or charge shall be paid. Upon filing the no certificate the board of trustees is a body corporate with 8 power to sue and be sued under the name of "Board of 9 10 Trustees of the Memorial Hospital of .... County". No 11 individual member of the board of trustees is personally 12 liable for any action or procedure of the board. The 13 corporation has perpetual existence and it is not necessary 14 to file any other or further certificate than that filed 15 upon the original organization of the board of trustees. 16 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2012. 17 18
