




#### Full Price Elk Licenses General Hunt Areas

# Preference Points (Nonresident Elk, Deer and Antelope) W.S. § 23-1-703(g)

2004 Legislative Session

Commission authority, through rule and regulation, develop and implement preference point drawing for nonresident elk, deer and antelope

Commission authority to establish fee for points Elk, Deer, Antelope not to exceed \$50 Moose and Bighorn Sheep not to exceed \$100

Species	Adult	Youth
Elk	\$50	\$10
Deer	\$40	\$10
Antelope	\$30	\$10

#### **Preference Point Rules for Sportsperson**

•One (1) preference point earned per year/per species

•Points obtained in one year are not used until next year drawing

•Points tied to species but not specific hunt area

•Points tied to Sportsperson identification number (SPID)

•Points lost if draw 1<sup>st</sup> choice license (all species)

•Points are not transferrable or refundable

•Points lost if don't obtain points within two (2) years

## How Preference Points Obtained (Moose and Bighorn Sheep)

<u>Participating in Limited Quota Drawing</u> -Unsuccessful in drawing -Residents earn point for no fee -Nonresidents point fee is retained from refund

#### <u>Purchase a Point</u>

-Submit application between July 1 – September 30 -Preference Point Fee Only (no application fee)

Quota allocated for each hunt area is split: 75% to preference point drawing 25% to random drawing

Licenses are allocated based on 1<sup>st</sup> hunt choices only

Preference point value used in the drawing is calculated for party applications to average points out 5 decimal places (Nonresident elk, deer and antelope drawings)













## **Big Game Licenses Sold**



#### **Trophy Game Licenses Sold**






